SITUATION/DIRECTIONS

From Hereford take the A438 towards Bridge Sollers and Eardisley. Continue along this road for approximately 8 miles until you reach the junction with A4112, before the village of Eardisley. Turn right towards Leominster. Continue along this road for approximately 2 miles and take the right hand turning sign posted Hurstley and Norton Canon. Continue along this road and the drive to the farm can be found after approximately 1 mile on the right-hand side.

From Leominster and the A49 take the A44 towards Dilwyn and Weobley. Continue along this road and then directly onto the A4112. Continue along this road for a further 4 miles and take the left hand turning sign posted Hurstley and Norton Canon. Continue along this road and the drive to the farm can be found after approximately 1 mile on the right-hand side.

2. Before any VAT refund can be processed, the required documentation must be submitted in full and deemed satisfactory by Sunderlands 1862 LLP.
3. Sunderlands 1862 LLP reserves the right to withhold the VAT refund until all necessary export verification documents have been received and verified.

If the purchaser fails to provide the required documentation, Sunderlands 1862 LLP will retain VAT, and no refund will be issued.

This condition will be strictly adhered to without exception

NB. All overseas purchasers should contact the auctioneers at least two days prior to the sale to register and confirm their VAT status.

MONEY LAUNDERING REGULATIONS
